Students Feedback Report: 2022-23

Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Amolakchand Vidhi Mahavidyalaya, Yavatmal is continuously following the tradition of collecting feedback from its students on the curriculum and teaching learning process adopted by the institution.

Objectives: the object behind this tradition which is mandatorily observed by the IQAC is to rightly determine the impact of all the efforts taken by the institution for the overall development of the students. Institution wants its benefit to be reached to all the students and it can only be determined through the feedback collected and analyzed.

Feedback is an important part of teaching learning process. The collection of feedback and analysis of it helps the institution to foresee the different needs and expectations of the students from the institution which would definitely helpful for the overall development of any educational institution.

IQAC Amolakchand Vidhi Mahavidyalaya Yavatmal has collected online feedback from the students of LL. B. 5 years and 3 Years course by providing questionnaire through Google Form. Total 126 students have responded to it. Review of the responses by students to the questions provided to them for the purpose of collecting feedback on curriculum and teaching learning process adopted by our institution reveals the following-

Response: Most of the students have positively responded to the question Do you think that the subjects included in the curriculum are satisfactory enough to stand them well in the legal profession? 84 % of the students have responded that they are happy with the contents of syllabus. Only 2 % of the students have suggested for the inclusion of some specialized subjects in the curriculum such as Taxation, Insurance Law, Psychology, Forensic, Music, POCSO Act, etc. 82% of the students are happy with the books, journals and E- library facility provided by our college. 11.1% of the students responded to this that they are up to some extent happy with the library facility available in the college. 90 % of the students have positively given response that they are benefitted from legal-aid, Lok-Adalat, Moot court etc. promoted by the college.

Feedback from the students on Teaching Learning process is so positive that almost all the students answered yes to the question and stated that 61.1 % syllabus covered in the classrooms. and Whether Teachers completes the Syllabus within prescribed time? 61% of the students have given positive response that they are happy with the teaching preparation by teachers. 73 % students responded that teachers are well in communication with them. 65.9 % students are happy with the internal evaluation by the teachers. 67 % students says that their performance in assignments discussed with them by the teachers. 68.3 % students says that college is taking active interest in promoting internship, student



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exchange, field visits opportunities for students. 73.62 % students answer that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

63 % students stated that to a great extent institute / teachers use student centric methods of experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies for enhancing learning experience, while 25.4 % answers is moderate efforts by the college.

60.3 % answer to the great extent and 28.6 % stated that moderate efforts are made by the institute / teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work.

68 % students are saying that teachers are using ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia etc. while teaching. 88.16 % students answer that the overall quality of teaching-learning process in the institution is very good; 86.3 % students said that the infrastructure facilities are adequate in the institute.

Suggestive Feedback

We have also taken suggestive feedback from the students for determining the satisfaction and expectation of the students from our college institution. In suggestive feedback some of the students have given some suggestions such as Availability of Xerox machine, Books in Marathi Language, Regularity in Functional canteen, Visit to Supreme Court & High Court, LL.M.

Analysis of the Report

Overall analysis of the feedback report of the students makes it very clear that they are well satisfied with the teaching learning process adopted by college and they are happy to be the part of our college for taking legal education. Students are very well satisfied with the library facility provided by our college. They are also happy with the co-operative nature of our college Teachers and administrative staff members. They are also benefitted by the guidance from the teachers as and when they needed. Thus, overall students have positively responded to the curriculum and teaching learning process. Off Course there are certain suggestive feedback however, college is already working on it.

Action Taken Report on the basis of Feedback in the academic year 2022-23

The suggestions given by the students are placed before the CDC. The management has already given consent for starting LL.M. After procedural requirement at University and Govt. Level it will begin probably from the Academic session 2024-25, For Add on Courses 3 P.G. Diplomas are started from the Academic session 2023-24.

The curriculum is in English Language, and it is for the betterment of the students to read Books in English. However few students interested in Marathi Books, College Library is having few Marathi Books, still more books will be purchased in Marathi Language.

So far as the regular canteen is concerned, Vendors are showing less interest due to less profit earning in a small college like us. Still, efforts will be made to arrange regular canteen facility.

Supreme Court visit is the suggestion, It is submitted that College has tried last year by sending permission application to the registrar of the Supreme Court, but due to some reason it could not sanctioned. College will again try to sought permission to visit Supreme Court.

Teachers Feedback Report (Academic Year 2022-23)

Teachers are the most important component of every educational Institution. Feedback from the faculty members plays a significant role in the development of Institution. Amolakchand Vidhi Mahavidyalaya also considers the significance of the opinion expressed by its teachers. So, IQAC of the Institution has collected online feedback from teachers for the academic year 2022-23. Eight teachers are serving as full-time faculty, including both the courses LL. B 3 years and B.A.LL.B. 5 years. Feedback collected from them revealed the following aspects:

Feedback Analysis:

- Most of the teachers (85.7%) covered 85 to 100% syllabus in the class and 14.3% of the teachers covered 70 to 84% of the syllabus.
- It is revealed from the collected responses that 42.9% of the teachers prepared thoroughly for the classes whereas 57.1% of the teachers prepared satisfactorily.
- 87.7% of the teachers are satisfied with the students support in the classroom and only 14.3% of them are satisfied to some extent.
- 57.1% of the teachers are of the opinion that sufficient ICT facilities are provided by the college for taking lectures whereas 42.9% are seem to be satisfied to some extent with the ICT facility provided by the college. There is no negative response to this.
- As to the question no.5 that is about the measures taken by the college for faculty retention it is revealed from the collected feedback that 28.6% of them are strongly agree whereas 71.4% are agree that the college has taken measures for it.
- All the teachers have responded positively on that adequate resources are available in college for encouraging active research involvement of teachers.
- 100% of the teachers are of the opinion that the college encourages them to participate in the seminars, workshops, etc.
- 42.9% of the teachers responded positively that they have been provided with the financial support to attend conferences/ workshops and toward membership fee of professional bodies publication and other academic incentives whereas 42.9% are of the opinion that they have been provided with this up to some extent. Only 14.3% have replied negatively.
- Relating to the library facility provided by the Institution, it is shown from the feedback analyzed there is 100% positive response that the College library is enriched with quality books, journals, eBooks & Software.

• Suggestive feedback

In suggestive feedback some of the teachers have suggested for providing more ICT facilities and Smart Classroom.

Alumni Feedback Report

Academic Year 2022-23

Vidya Prasarak Mandal's Amolachand Vidhi Mahavidyalaya Yavatmal has maintained the tradition of collecting feedback from its stakeholders as such it has collected feedback from its alumni for the year 2022-23. Considering the advancement of the information technology and availability of internet facility all over the college has collected online feedback from its alumni by feeding the questions in the Google form. In all total 10 questions were fed up to which 16 responses received on the basis of which the present report is prepared. These 16 responses are from alumni of both LL.B. 3 years and 5 years course.

93.8% of the alumni have responded positively that they are satisfied with the college and the degree achieved by them. 6.2% of the alumni have given response that they are happy with the College and their degree up to some extent. There is no negative response to it.

In answer to the question that if the curriculum implemented by the college is beneficial for them in their professional carrier, 93.8% of the alumni feel it positively whereas 6.2% of the alumni responded that they don't feel that it is beneficial for them.

As to answer to the question no. 3 it is found that most of the alumni are satisfied with the subjects included in the curriculum are of the opinion that they are enough to stand them well in legal profession. When suggestion is taken as to the inclusion of any new additional subject in the syllabus 25% have responded negatively and only 43.8% of them have suggested for inclusion of new subject in the syllabus whereas 31.3% of the alumni can't say exactly about it.

62.5% of the alumni are agreed on that college library is enriched enough to satisfy their reading greed relating to the curriculum including e-resources. 25% of them have given negative response to this and 12.5% of them are satisfied with library facility up to some extent.



In answer to the question relating to the cooperation of administrative staff most of the alumni (93.8%) are satisfied with cooperation of the administrative staff in the college. Only 6.2% of them are replied that they are satisfied up to some extent. It is found from the responses that there is no negative reply to this question. 87.5% of the alumni have responded positively that institute provides them an opportunity to participate in extracurricular activities and also provides adequate facilities for their overall development. From response to the question no.9, it is shown that the most of the alumni loved to become member of active alumni association by donating money, books, gifts etc. to the alumni association of the College.

Suggestive Feedback

In suggestive feedback alumni have suggested for making available placements facility and career counselling, they have also suggested to start PG Programme.

Analysis of the Feedback Received

Overall analysis of the feedback collected from the alumni for the year 2022-23 makes it clear that all are happy being the part of the Amolakchand Vidhi Mahavidyalaya, Yavatmal and also with degree obtained by them. They are satisfied with the adopted curriculum and subjects taught in the college and are of the opinion that these are enough the stand them well in legal profession. They are also satisfied with the library facility provided including e-resources. They are happy with the cooperation received from the college for engaging them with extracurricular activities which are helpful for their overall development. In suggestive feedback suggestions received by the alumni are always welcome and surely will be considered for its implementation.
